## **DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS**

- Refill Spray bottle and dilute concentrate with clean water at a ratio of 1:9.
- Use 5 capfuls per spray bottle.
- 2.5 fluid oz or 75ml of concentrate per bottle.
- 1 Gallon makes up 10 gallons of STONE CARE SPRAY.
- 1 litre makes up 10 litres of STONE CARE SPRAY.
